

BILL SAVINGS

Pay less for the electricity and gas you're using in your homes.

Want discounts on your bills?

Family Electric Rate Assistance (FERA) and California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) can cut your gas and electric bills by 12-35%. Time-of-Use (TOU) Rate Plans can also lower the cost of electricity at certain times of the day.

Low-Income Discount, Low-Water Rebate, Share Project, and Subsidized Housing Assistance Relief for Energy

programs offer rebates and financial assistance to lower bills.

Need a higher medical allowance?

Medical Baseline Allowances can save \$85-\$170/month on utility bills if you rely on electricity or gas for life support equipment or treatment of a life-threatening illness. **The Lifeline Rate Program and Life-Support/Physician-Certified Discount** offer additional bill discounts.

In a financial crisis?

One-time financial assistance is available through the **Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)**, **Energy Assistance Fund (EAF)**, **Gas Assistance Fund (GAF)**, and **Relief for Energy Assistance Through Community Help (REACH)**.

Let's take a look at the facts:

Your community is bearing the burden of pollution and climate change vulnerability.

This means significant health concerns, from exposure to toxic pollutants and increased heat in the summers, to increased chance of asthma and heart disease.

Air pollution can kill. Polluted air in Orange County, Los Angeles, Riverside, and San Bernardino causes up to 5,000 premature deaths per year.

It will get even hotter. Polluted areas will get hotter in the future, increasing health risks and discomfort.

HOME EFFICIENCY

Want free upgrades?

The Energy Savings Assistance Program (ESA), Home Energy Improvement Program, Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), as well as the Residential Direct Install (RDI) program, offer free energy efficient upgrades.

City Plants and the **Mobile Home Upgrade Program** offer resources to improve energy efficiency.

HOME REPAIR

Health and safety-related repairs are available.

Interested in home improvements?

Handyworker Program, Residential Sound Insulation, and Single Family Home Improvements provide between \$5,000 and \$15,000 for home repairs.

Ready for new appliances?

EnergyStar, SoCal Water\$mart, Energy Upgrade California, and the Thermal Low-Income Program provide rebates for the purchase of energy-efficient appliances that reduce your energy and water bills.



SOLAR ENERGY

Generate your own power and reduce your energy bills.

Considering solar?

The **Single-Family Affordable Solar Homes (SASH)** and **Low Income Weatherization Program (LIWP)** programs provide rebates to help cover solar installation costs.

Already have solar?

Net Energy Metering allows you to sell excess energy you generate to your utility in exchange for a bill credit.

ALTERNATIVE AND SHARED MOBILITY

Use alternative forms of transportation to save money and improve air quality.

Car and bikeshare programs, vanpooling services, and the Replace Your Ride transit voucher offer alternatives to driving your own car.



CLEAN VEHICLES

Reduce fuel costs and improve local air quality by upgrading your vehicle.

Struggling to pass your smog test?

The **Consumer Assistance Program (CAP)** and **Enhanced Fleet Modernization Program (EFMP)** can help cover the cost of emissions-related repairs or help you trade in your car for a new electric or hybrid vehicle.

Ready for a clean energy vehicle?

The **Clean Vehicle Rebate Project (CVRP)** and **Drive Clean! Rebate Program** offer rebates and discounts of \$3,000 - \$7,000 for purchasing or leasing a new electric vehicle or plug-in hybrid. The **Used EV Rebate** offers up to \$450 for the purchase of a used EV. The **Nissan LEAF Rebate** offers a \$3,500 rebate for LEAFs.

The **Clean Vehicle Assistance Program** and **Replace Your Ride** programs offer grants, financing options, and vouchers for a new electric or hybrid vehicle. The **Federal EV Tax Credit Program** offers \$2,500-\$7,500 in tax credits for the purchase of a new electric vehicle or plug-in hybrid. **California's Low Carbon Fuel Standard Program Clean Fuel Rewards Program** gives out \$450-\$1,000 for new or used electric vehicle or plug-in hybrid.

Interested in faster charging at home?

The **Residential EV Charging Incentive Pilot** and **Charge Ready Home Installation Rebate Program** offer rebates for installing Level 2 Chargers at your home, which work 4-5 faster than your standard wall outlets.
